ABOUT THE PROGRAM

At Hy-Vee, we believe our helpful smiles – our people – are our most important asset. And we are committed to cultivating the future by investing in our helpful smiles. The Hy-Vee Foundation Scholarship Program exists to provide financial assistance to help students achieve their educational goals. Since 1969, more than \$2.5 million in scholarships has been awarded to high school and college students from the Hy-Vee Foundation. For the 2020-2021 school year, 90 - \$1,000 scholarships are available to qualifying high school and college students. See program guidelines and full eligibility requirements below.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS – HIGH SCHOOL

Applicant must be:

- A high-school senior employed with Hy-Vee (office, distribution, retail) or subsidiary locations who began employment on or before September 15, 2019 or a high school senior son or daughter of a full-, regular-, or part-time Hy-Vee or subsidiary employee who has a minimum of six months employment as of September 15, 2019,

Applicant must not be:

- An immediate family member of a Hy-Vee Vice President or above. All other employees and their family members who meet the other eligibility requirements may apply.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS – COLLEGE

Applicant must be:

- Employed with Hy-Vee (office, distribution, retail) or subsidiary locations on or before June 1, 2019.
- Classified as a full-time student in his/her freshman, sophomore, or junior year during time of application process.
- Classified as a full-time sophomore, junior, or senior at the time funds are disbursed.

Applicant must not be:

- An immediate family member of a Hy-Vee Vice President or above. All other employees and their family members who meet the other eligibility requirements may apply.

APPLICATION

The scholarship application and required supporting documents must be:

- Typed – Handwritten submissions will not be considered
- Submitted via U.S. Mail
- Postmarked on or before February 28, 2020 to Hy-Vee Foundation, 5820 Westown Pkwy, West Des Moines, IA 50266.

USING THE SCHOLARSHIP

- Recipients may use scholarship funds to pay all normal college expenses including tuition, room and board, book purchases, and rentals. Refundable fees will not be paid. Maximum value of each full award is \$1,000, payable in a lump sum payment.
- Winners may attend any baccalaureate degree-granting college in the United States.
- Winners may enroll at an accredited two-year college provided the course of study will lead to later granting of a baccalaureate degree.
- There are no restrictions as to the course of study selected by a scholarship winner except that the program must lead to a four-year degree.

ACCEPTING OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS

Hy-Vee Foundation Scholarship recipients are free to accept other scholarships, but must report any with financial awards to the Hy-Vee Foundation. Specifically this rule requires notification to the Hy-Vee Foundation of other scholarship awards providing tuition-free assistance.

BEFORE YOU APPLY

We advise reading the information below before you start your application so you can be fully prepared. The application and supporting materials must be typed and postmarked on or before February 28, 2020 to qualify.

Important Items You Will Need:

- A transcript
- A typed personal statement describing a time when Hy-Vee made a difference in your life and/or the life of a customer
- A typed resume, including accomplishments in academics, activities, arts, athletics, community service and future postsecondary plans
- A personal reference regarding your skills and qualifications
- **High School students ONLY** – ACT or SAT examination scores

TRANSCRIPT

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Your transcript must include high school grades along with your first semester senior grades, and grade point. **Note:** If your ACT/SAT scores are included as a part of your official transcript, separate results are not necessary.

COLLEGE STUDENTS

Your transcript must include all grades including transfer schools, your accumulated GPA, as well as your most current GPA.

PERSONAL STATEMENT

Describe a time when Hy-Vee made a difference in your life and/or the life of your customer(s). Your statement must be typed and have a minimum of 300 words up to a maximum of 500 words. Please attach a separate sheet.

RESUME

The Hy-Vee Foundation is interested in not only your academic standing, but also your accomplishments, involvements and future plans. On a separate sheet, please submit a typed resume listing accomplishments in academics, activities, arts, and athletics, community service and future postsecondary plans.

Areas to consider:

- **Student Organizations** (student council, class office, clubs, yearbook, newspaper, etc.)
- **Athletics** (various sports teams, honors, etc.)
- **Art, Music, Speech/Drama** (vocal, instrumental, debate teams, theater productions, etc.)
- **Community Involvement, Philanthropy** (church, Boys/Girls State, 4-H, FFA, choirs, youth work)
- **Other** (National Honor Society, scholarships, activities, awards, etc.)
- **Future Plans** (Anticipated field of study, major, career choice, college/university attending)

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PERSONAL REFERENCE

Ask a teacher, professor, counselor, administrator, Hy-Vee store director or supervisor to complete a personal reference regarding your skills and qualifications, including college potential, personal attributes, work ethic, general ability, and worthiness of a Hy-Vee Foundation scholarship.

Areas to consider:

- **Communication Skills** (ability to express verbally and in writing, ability to be assertive, listening skills)
- **Leadership Qualities** (organization skills, ability to motivate others, innovativeness, judgment, flexibility)
- **Responsibility and Maturity** (dependability, role modeling, consistency)
- **Personal Skills and Traits** (honesty, tolerance & appreciation of diversity, patience, sensitivity to others, level of commitment)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How many scholarships are available?

There are 90 - \$1,000 scholarships available for the 2020-2021 school year to qualifying high school and college students.

Can I apply multiple years for the scholarship?

Qualified students are eligible to apply every year.

How do I apply?

Eligible candidates should submit an application and required supporting documents to Hy-Vee Foundation, 5820 Westown Pkwy, West Des Moines, IA 50266. All documents must be postmarked on or before February 28, 2020 in order to qualify.

What information do I need?

- A typed application
- A transcript
- A typed personal statement
- A typed resume
- A personal reference regarding your skills and qualifications
- High School students ONLY – ACT or SAT examination scores (if not included in official transcript)

Can materials be sent separately?

Applications and all required supporting documents must be sent together to be considered for a scholarship.

Can I drop my application off in person?

Applications must be sent via U.S. Mail and postmarked on or before February 28, 2020 in order to qualify.

When will the winners be announced?

Scholarship winners will be announced following the confirmation from the Hy-Vee Foundation, which oversees the judge's selection process. Decisions will be announced via email during the month of May. A scholarship becomes confirmed upon proof of enrollment in college by the prospective recipient.

What costs will the award cover?

Recipients may use scholarship funds to pay all normal college expenses including tuition, room and board, book purchases, and rentals. Refundable fees will not be paid. Maximum value of each full award is \$1,000, payable in a lump sum payment.

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How will the scholarship be awarded?

Scholarships will be sent directly to the college on August 1 to be credited to your account.

What college may I attend?

- Winners may attend any baccalaureate degree-granting college in the United States.
- Winners may enroll at an accredited two-year college provided the course of study will lead to later granting of a baccalaureate degree.
- There are no restrictions as to the course of study selected by a scholarship winner except that the program must lead to a four-year degree.

Am I able to accept other scholarships?

Hy-Vee Foundation Scholarship recipients are free to accept other scholarships, but must report any with financial awards to the Hy-Vee Foundation. Specifically this rule requires notification to the Hy-Vee Foundation of other scholarship awards providing tuition-free assistance.
